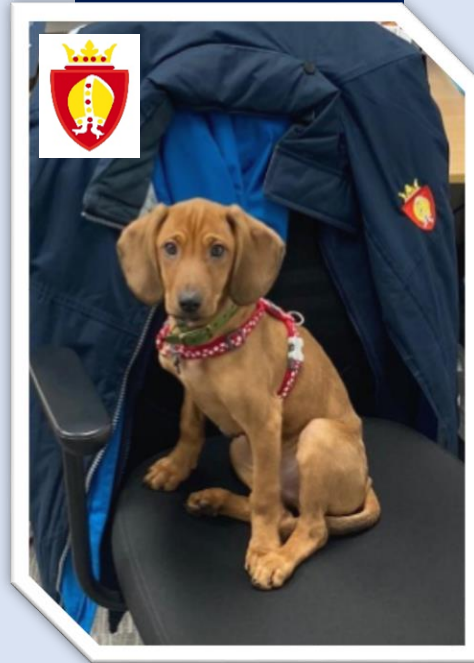

Friends fur-ever!

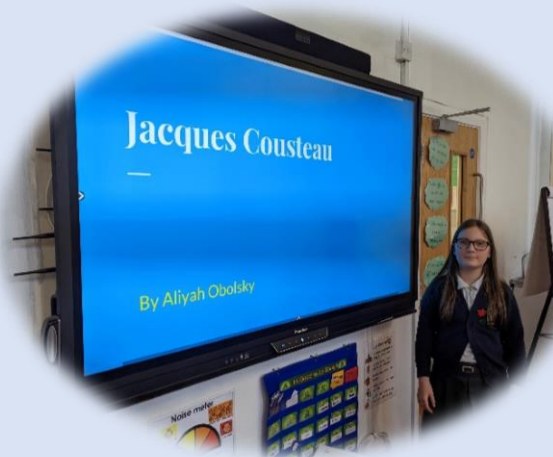
