Dear Class 2,

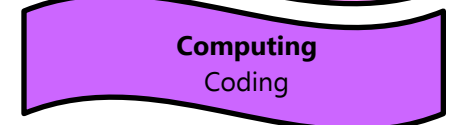

We have settled into our new classroom quickly and I look forward to welcoming you to the Meet the Teacher meeting later this month.

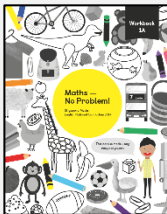

Homework Notice!

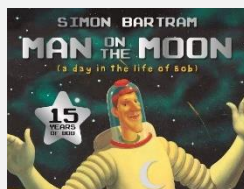
Every Friday homework will be uploaded to Google Classroom. Homework should be handed in on Thursday via Google Classroom.
