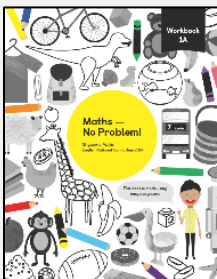

Homework Notice!

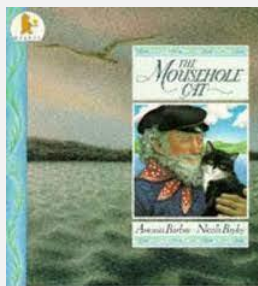
Homework should be handed in on Friday every week. The new homework will be set on the following Monday, this will include handwriting practice and mental maths.
