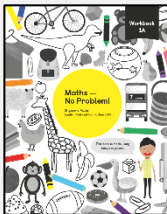

Homework Notice!

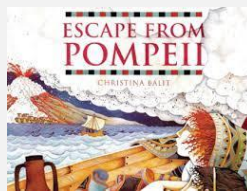
Every Monday homework will be sent home in Handwriting Books. Homework should be handed in on Fridays when we will have our Spelling and Times Table Tests.
