This year was the first year without Levels. The Government introduced Age Related Expectations (ARE) for a 7-year-old pupil. There is no comparison with the old system. (1 child = 3.3%)

20 pupils met 'expected standard' in Reading, Writing and Mathematics = 67%. The National average is 53%. There was 40% mobility from Reception to Year 6.

10 pupils joined St Mary Abbots School in KS2 (33%). 12 pupils new to school from Year 2 to Year 4 (40%).
