Sports Premium Plan 2022-23

At St Mary Abbots we use our Sports Premium funding £17,580 in the following ways:

- To provide all of our children across the school with specialist PE coaching, on a weekly basis
- To provide CPD for non-PE specialists
- To provide access to sporting competitions and resources
- To help finance our swimming programme

During the 2022-23 academic year we plan to spend the Sports Premium in the following way was:

Activity	Cost	Planned Impact
Specialist PE Coaching	£10,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children will benefit from high level teaching, which would not usually be available from non-PE specialists• Children will benefit from a broad curriculum, as the specialist has extensive knowledge of a range of sports• Other members of staff to benefit from the PE specialist by way of CPD• Children will improve their fundamental motor skills and will be able to apply them to specific sports• Children's ability to work both independently, and as part of a team, will grow through an enhanced PE plan• The PE coach will plan lessons that will help develop children's learning in other subject areas, by using cross curricular links
Competitions & resources	£1,580	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• High attaining pupils will be given the chance to compete outside of school• A broad range of children will be able to compete in non-elitest events• Children will benefit from high level teaching, supported by quality resources
Year 3 Swimming	£6000	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children will be taught to swim, which is an essential life skill• Children will swim competently, confidently, and proficiently over a distance of at least 25m (as per the National Curriculum)• Children will use a range of strokes effectively, such as front crawl, backstroke, and breaststroke (as per the National Curriculum)• Children will be able to perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations (as per the National Curriculum)• Children will develop in an area of PE that is not associated with activities such as games-based sports
