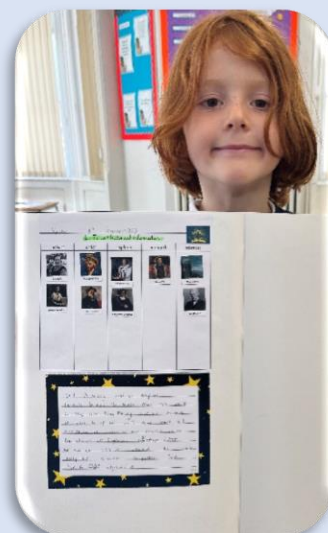
Friday 22nd September - Issue 2

Class 2 have been looking at significant people from history in their *Movers and Shakers* unit. They have been sorting them into different categories (activist, artist, explorer, monarch and scientist) and learnt many interesting facts.

Class 1 have been looking at the Creation Story in RE. They have learned about how this links to the world that we live in today, and discussed ways that we can look after our world properly.



Class 3 have been looking at the ways that different artists use colours and their reasons for doing so. The class selected two paintings to compare using specific language around colour.



Class 4 have been mixing different hues of secondary colours using the primary colours in Art. They used watercolours and practised painting wet - on - wet and wet on dry to give different effects.



Class 5 have been researching key beliefs and religious rituals within the Shang Dynasty. They created wonderful fact files to present all of their findings.
