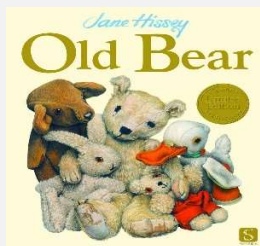
Every Monday homework will be given to you, along with your handwriting book. Please complete your homework and hand it in on the Friday of that week.
