Dear Class 1,

Welcome back! I hope you had a lovely half term and are ready for the final weeks of year 1! We have lots of exciting learning to look forward to, a final forest school session and a very exciting trip to the Fulham Palace Victorian era session!

In English, we will be continuing to look at books relating to our new topic School Days. We are also going to continue to develop our story writing skills that we began to explore last half term.

In Maths, we will be looking at numbers to 100 and reviewing all of the topics which we have covered so far this academic year in maths, ready for year 2!

Spellings: Each week 10 spellings will be sent home for the children to learn. We will continue to have our spelling test every Friday. The words sent home are from the Year 1 Spelling list and topic specific vocabulary. Sometimes difficult words will be repeated to ensure they are learnt effectively.

RSE: In this unit, children will learn the scientifically accurate names for their private parts (vulva and penis) and why they are called private parts, as part of this topic on privacy and independence in the bathroom.

Every Monday handwriting, mental maths and spelling homework will be set. Homework is due every Friday. Please remember to bring in your handwriting books every Friday!


Maths
