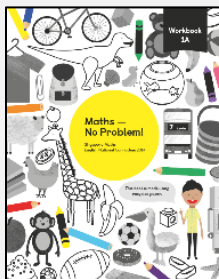

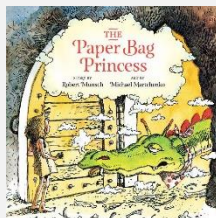
Every Monday homework will be handed out. Please ensure it is completed and returned on Friday, we will also complete our spelling test Friday morning.

## **RSE**

### **Year 2**

In this unit, children will label the body parts of children with clothes on, in swimwear and naked, using the scientifically appropriate names (penis, vulva, testicles and nipples). They will also think about what makes boys and girls different and remind children of the importance of keeping their genitals private. They will learn that they use their penis and vulva to release urine from the body. The children will also discuss whom they could talk to if they felt unsafe in any situation.
