Swimming is still every Monday so please remember all of your swimming kit on Mondays and your PE kit on Thursdays.



Homework Notice!


Every Monday homework will be sent home in Handwriting Books. Homework should be handed in on Fridays when we will have our Spelling and Times Table Tests.
