We will use our Science and History topics to support us with our writing. If you would like to do further independent research or creative work linked to these topics, please keep an eye out for the project work in your weekly homework!

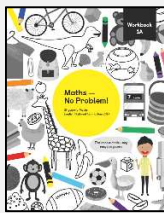
Later in the term, we will be focusing on our KS1 Christmas production too. This will be a wonderful occasion and we look forward to welcoming you to this before the end of term!

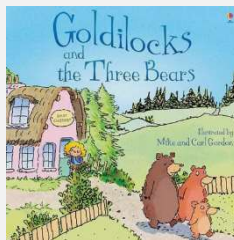
Every Monday homework will be given to you, along with your handwriting book. Please complete your homework and hand it in on the Friday of that week.
