Later in the term, of course we will focus on our KS1 Christmas production too. This will be a wonderful occasion and we look forward to welcoming you to this before the end of term!

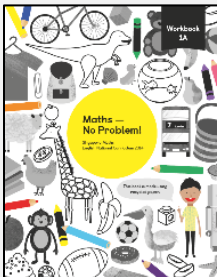
