
In Science, we will be looking in greater depth at the bones, muscles and joints of the human body and we will be carrying out an investigation to discover more around this.

Homework Notice!


Every Monday homework will be sent home alongside Handwriting Books. Homework should be handed in on Fridays when we will have our Spelling and Times Table Tests.
