



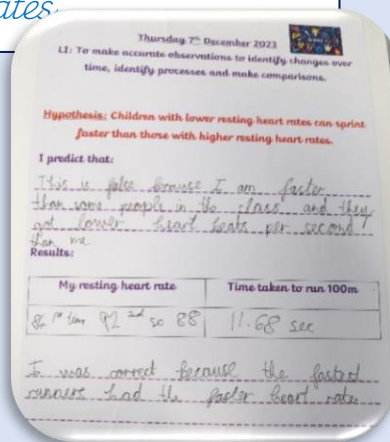
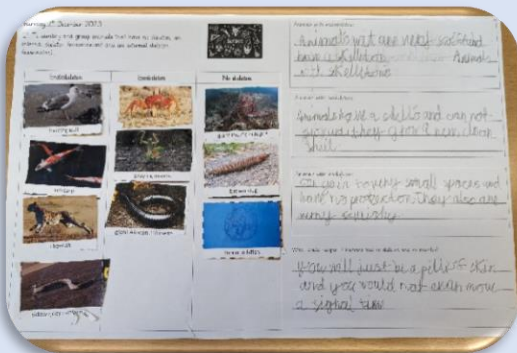
# SMAil

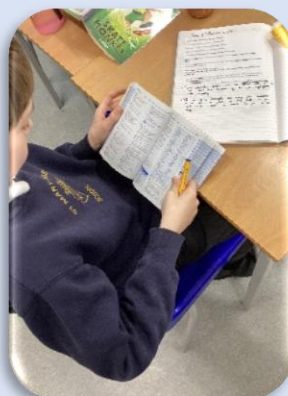
