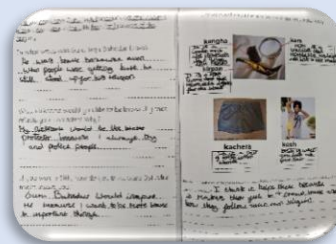
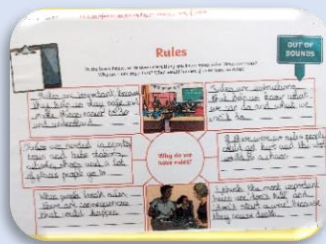
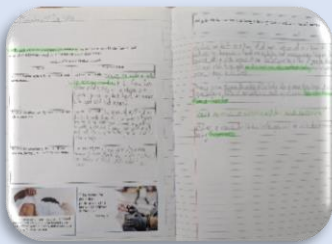
Welcome back everyone! Let's take a look at what classes have been up to in the first week back!

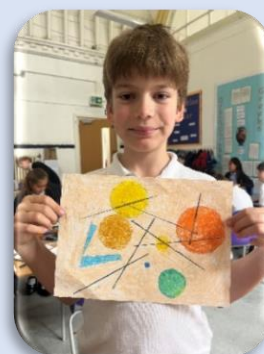
Class 3 had a fantastic day visiting a Buddhist Temple, where they met a monk who taught them about different Buddhist practices and traditions. They learnt all about the importance of respect, living a good life and making good choices, which leads to good karma.



Class 4 have been learning about Hindu funerals and beliefs about reincarnation. Class 5 have been thinking about Guru Tegh Bahadur and how his bravery inspires Sikhs today. Class 6 have been reflecting on what rules are and why they are needed in different contexts, linking to Christian responsibilities, decisions and consequences.



Class 5 visited the immersive art experience *Frameless*. They looked at masterpieces from some of the World's greatest artists and had a go at re-creating their own, inspired by Kandinsky.
