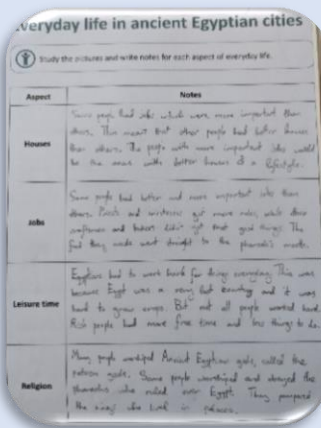
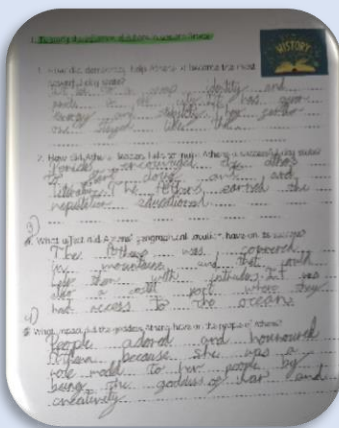
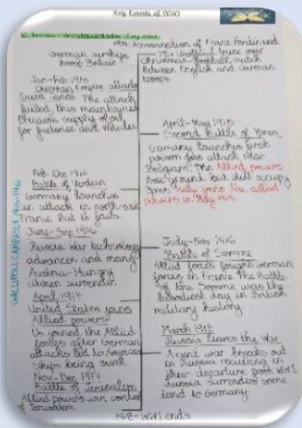


*Let's see what fantastic learning, trips and other exciting events have been happening this week...*

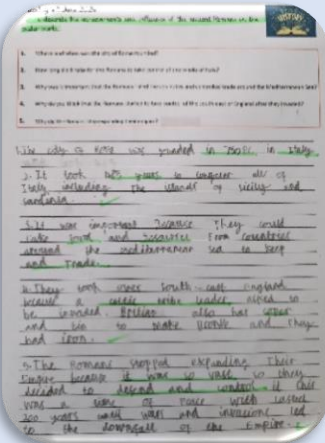
