




Classes have been hard at work this week – let's see what Maths and Science looks like across the school!

In Maths, Reception Class compared the mass of objects on balance scales, and used *heavier* or *lighter* to describe them. Class 1 practised their positional language to describe directions to solve problems. Class 2 completed journal tasks to find halves of an amount.



Class 4 have looked at electrical conductors and insulators and discussed what they are used for in everyday life. Class 3 observed how water travels through the roots of the plant, up through the stem and into the leaves.
