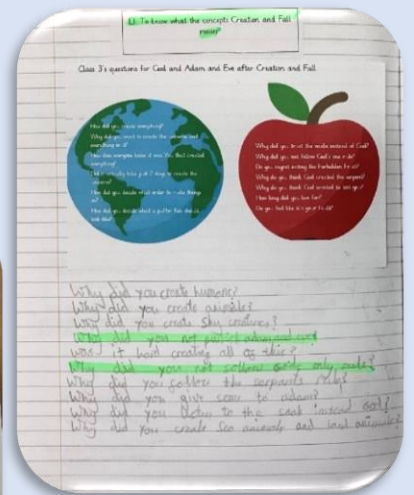
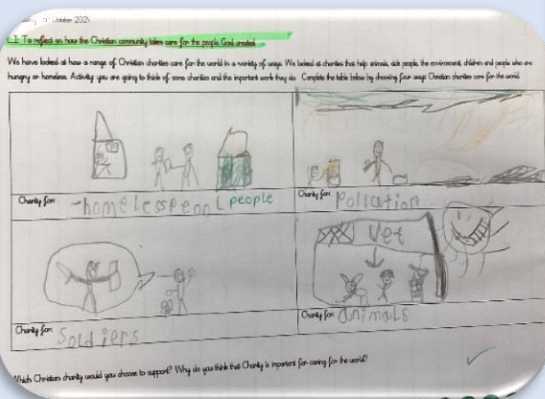

Class 2 have been learning about the Lord's Prayer and this week focused on forgiveness.

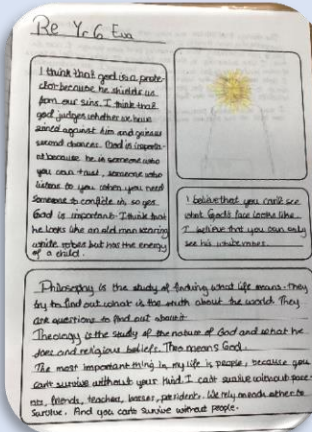

Class 1 have been learning about Creation and the responsibility we have to take care of God's creations.



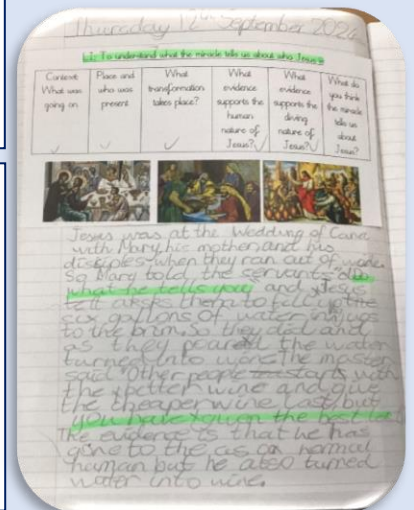
Class 6 have been learning about the Christian perspective of the journey of life and death.
