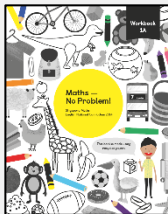
I look forward to welcoming you to the Meet the Teacher meeting later this month.

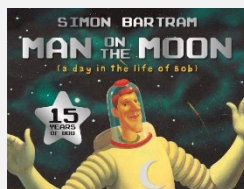
Homework Notice!
